PRIVATE JEEP TOUR – VINEYARD VISIT AND LUNCH – FULL DAY (early booking recommended)



This is the most popular day out, taking in the whole of the western side of this island, the most dramatic and breathtaking scenery. Visit the viewpoint (Skywalk) at **Cabo Girão**, the highest sea cliff in Europe and the second highest in the world (580m). Travel inland across the mysterious plateau of **Paúl da Serra** to **Porto Moniz** with its natural volcanic rock pools. Our journey continues to **São Vicente**, a pretty mountain village, along the northwestern coastal road where waterfalls cascade down the rockface into the deep blue ocean. Arriving at **São Vicente**, its time to visit a vineyard property, where you will be tasting the table wines produced in there, white, red and rosé wines. Enjoy a traditional lunch of 'Espetada' , a regional dish made in an open kitchen. The delicious grilled chunks of beef marinated in garlic, bay leaves and salt is served on a 3 ft skewer, served with boiled potatoes and salad and accompanied by the house red or white wines.

An amazing experience, with remarkable views over the valley and surrounding mountains!

MADEIRA WINE LODGE PREMIUM TOUR – 45MIN



Over the centuries, the excellent wine produced in Madeira has carried the archipelago's name to the four corners of the world. An inescapable part of this secular History is told at The Blandy's Wine Lodge. This space is located in a group of Baroque civil architecture buildings, including the oldest Madeira wine cellars, dating from the 17th and 18th centuries. The old Convent of São Francisco used to stand in the vicinity before being demolished in the 19th century. In 1913 the 'Madeira Wine Association', now called 'Madeira Wine Company', was founded, through which several companies or independent growers were associated. The Blandy's Wine Lodge currently houses a museum of great interest. In the exhibition area, visitors can witness the Madeira wine journey, from the vineyard production process to its transformation, including an explanation of its various varieties: Sercial, Malvasia, Verdelho and Boal. In addition, at the Blandy's Wine Lodge, you can visit tasting rooms, ageing rooms and even a wine shop, offering an excellent range of products.

Laurissilva Forest - The island of Madeira is the proud guardian of an environmental heritage of inestimable importance. The Laurissilva forest, which is about 20 million years old, dates back to the Miocene and Pliocene periods of the Tertiary Period. Nonetheless, the mark of time, which makes it a 'living fossil', does not seem to affect its vibrant energy. If in that ancestral past it was distributed throughout the south of Europe and the north of Africa, after climate changes determined by the formation of the Mediterranean, the Laurissilva forest ended up finding in island regions its last refuge. Currently, it occupies an area of around 15.000 hectares in Madeira, which corresponds to 20% of the island, with greater expression in the high areas of the north. This subtropical rainforest is composed mainly of species endemic to Macaronesia. It is a vast ecosystem that shelters a diversified fauna and flora, where the trees, many of which are centuries-old, of the Lauraceae family (to which the Laurissilva forest owes its name) stand out. UNESCO World Heritage since 1999, the Laurissilva forest is a unique natural treasure. Walk along the trails and 'levadas' that cross it and enjoy the privilege of being connected to this green area of Madeira. A 20-million-year-old subtropical rainforest, the Laurissilva forest dates back to the Tertiary Age. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, it is an invaluable environmental heritage. **Halfday Levada Walking – 34€ price per pax / Fullday Levada Walking – 44€ price per pax – On request, subject to availability**
